Tara Festival of Crafts Terms and Conditions

The Tara Festival of Crafts Committee (The Committee) provides the following terms and conditions for vendors to ensure the show runs smoothly for everyone. These rules will be strictly enforced and, if not followed, may result in the termination and/or forfeiture of your space for current and/or future shows.

1. This agreement will become binding upon deposit of the vendors payment. No refunds of rental fees after September 1 of the show year. If your cheque is returned for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF), your space is cancelled.
2. This is a quality juried craft show, only handmade Canadian crafts are acceptable. Purchased components may be used to complete crafts only. Crafts not approved on the application and not meeting the juried criteria will not be allowed to remain in the show.
3. The show is always held the weekend after Thanksgiving, open to the public Friday 1PM to 9PM & Saturday 10AM to 5PM. Vendor setup times are Thursday 1PM to 3PM & Friday 7AM to 12PM. **Vendors not registered by 10:30 AM on Friday forfeit their spot.** All vendors must be setup by 12PM on Friday. No vendor may pack up early during the above-mentioned show hours.
4. **Please go to the show office BEFORE setting up your space to register and receive your vendor tags, booth number for display, and parking slip.** Up to 2 vendor tags per space. **Vendor tags must be worn at all times**, or you will not be admitted after registering. Parking slip must be displayed in vehicle immediately after registering.
5. Be considerate of your neighbour. Unloading areas are temporary parking spaces for unloading only. Please empty your vehicle and move it to the parking area before setting up.
6. Your booth number must be visible at all times.
7. All vendors must display within the boundaries of their space, nothing may crowd the aisles.
8. The space rented by the vendor cannot be sublet, transferred or leased. If the registered vendor is unable to attend for any reason, the space is cancelled. Any space cancelled after September 1 of the show year forfeits their payment.
9. Vendors with food products must register with the GreyBruce Public Health Unit: www.publichealthgreybruce.on.ca
10. Make sure you have enough inventory. If you run out and close your booth early you will not be invited back.
11. All tables and chairs must be booked and paid for with the application and are non-refundable, even if no longer required on show day. Tables must be skirted by the vendor.
12. Pets are not allowed in any part of the complex where the show is held.
13. The Municipality of Arran-Elderslie (The Municipality) will not permit on-site overnight camping at the Community Centre. Please source an alternative location for your camping trailer prior to arrival.
14. The vendor assumes all responsibility for all insurance of their space and contents and will show it upon request.
15. For safety and insurance purposes, no open flames or space heaters are allowed. Some spaces may experience a draft due to open entry doors or other building features. Please dress appropriately.
16. The Committee is not responsible for any loss or damage caused by the vendor. Nails, staples or thumb tacks cannot be used on tables, walls or floors.
17. The Committee, The Municipality and its staff shall not be responsible for damage, fire, theft, liability, injury, or acts of God. The vendor participates entirely at his/her own risk. Every exhibit must be supervised at all times; The Committee has volunteers to help with this.
18. The vendor agrees to abide by these terms and conditions. Failure to do so may result in the vendor being excluded from future shows. The vendor agrees that The Committee may adopt and/or amend any regulations deemed necessary prior to and during the show.
